Over the last year, we have established some amazing ongoing relationships with local corporations.

Kichler is a luxury lighting brand that specializes in indoor and outdoor lighting. We receive regular donations of ceiling fans, chandeliers, sconces, vanity lights, porch sconces, and landscape lights. These items are damaged boxed goods or returns that we inspect and assemble before sale. Our Sales Specialist, Sam, heads up our lighting department and is great at assisting our customers in finding lights that fit their needs. We have more than doubled our lighting department footprint, and this last quarter saw a 109% increase in lighting sales compared to last year.

Williams Sonoma is another wonderful and generous partner for us, with scratch and dent and returned merchandise. From bathroom fixtures to furniture to home decor, we have seen it all. We have seen a 62% increase in those departments this quarter compared to last year.

We have also seen great success with GreenSheen paint, an eco-friendly, low-VOC, recycled paint. It is a premium eggshell interior/exterior latex offered in 18 pre-tinted shades and is extremely affordable at \$18 per gallon. We have sold nearly 1,800 units of gallon and fivegallon buckets in the last year. Our customer feedback has been great, with multiple repeat purchases. Plus, since we were selling paint, we decided to offer a large selection of paint supplies to be your one-stop-shop for that weekend project.

These corporate donors and partners have helped increase sales and transaction counts and brought in many new customers just from word of mouth. It has been a joy to serve our community by supplying premium items at affordable prices for our customers while generating more funds for current and future homeowners in Gwinnett and Walton counties.

We have already completed Home #154 in Lawrenceville for Karli and her family and Home W12 in Monroe for Margaret and her family. Both families will be dedicating their homes and moving in later in June. We are excited that they will achieve their dream of homeownership this summer.

Construction has already begun on two additional homes in Lawrenceville. We are grateful for the partnership with the City of Lawrenceville, which donated the four lots to construct these homes. Another great feature of this partnership is that city employees will volunteer to help build two complete homes. We really appreciate the city's willingness to address affordable housing. Our hope is that this will be a pilot program that other cities can emulate in the future.

Later this summer, we will begin construction on two more homes that will move us closer to our goal of serving eight families this year with our homeownership program. This is only possible due to the success of our **Build Better** capital campaign, which will provide the funds to complete 24 homes over the next three years.
