community. Together, we're making a meaningful impact!



Executive Director's Corner

This year is moving along so fast. We have already completed five homes this year, started the sixth home in Monroe, and will start the final two homes in Loganville in the next few weeks. This year has also been a banner year for our repair programs. Our A Brush with Kindness (ABWK) home repair program serving the elderly, disabled, and veterans has served 15 households and is gearing up for a busy fall. Our new plumbing repair program, Water Resources Assistance Program (WRAP), has served 170 households with plumbing repairs since its inception in March of 2022. Our WRAP program also received the 2023 Hammer Time Repair Award at the Georgia Habitat Conference in June for the affiliate demonstrating an innovative repair program that increases the number of households served. We are so proud of our WRAP team and all they have accomplished.

We are on pace to serve over 180 families this fiscal year with all our programs, which will be the most we have ever served! We truly appreciate all our donors and volunteers that are making dreams

come true for families in our community. None of this would be possible without your support!

We are already planning for 2024, which will include the start of a new 14-home neighborhood in Lilburn. This is only possible due to the success of our **Build Better** capital campaign, which is providing the funds to complete 24 homes by the end of 2025. With your support, we are **building better** foundations for families in Gwinnett & Walton Counties!
